The authenticity of a data is challenging to judge in that the data we search on the internet seldom turns out to be impartial. (1) The Internet is usually referred to as a sea of information - ran by algorithms - while the truth seems quite different in an individual taste regard. (2) When a person considers an argument between two people-which was in fact quite fluctuated—to be won by one, for example, the Internet does not easily display information about the other seemingly having won the argument. (3) Therefore, biased search results induce an individual to be inclined to an original idea-or his idea-to make sure he can have himself inducted into the wider aspect of the original one. (4) However, with respect to a wider extent, as communities consist of people who share similar characteristics on particular themes, they are prone to drive themselves into specific limitations of the decision-making process. (⑤) Therefore, they consistently keep contemplating their common idea in depth, exhibiting wider version of echo-chamber effect.
